☐ Step 1: Application

- a. Complete the online application at <https://tiseagles.com/admissions/apply>
- b. Prepare the following previous school records
 - i. Applicants previous school records (2 year minimum)
 - ii. Completed TIS High School Credit Request from previous school (Grade 9 second semester and above applicants).
- c. Submit the following documents
 - i. Applicant's passport
 - ii. Applicant's current visa
 - iii. Copy of parent passport (father or mother)
 - iv. Copy of parent current visa (father or mother)

☐ Step 2: Admissions testing day

- a. Schedule a testing day with the Admissions office
 - i. ECC: Teacher interview
 - ii. Grade 1–2: English language test and teacher interview
 - iii. Grade 3–12: MAP tests (reading and math), English language test and teacher interview
- b. Complete online enrollment through PowerSchool
- c. Submit busing application form (if required)
- d. Submit FC/JK/K Questionnaire (ECC students only)
- e. Pay application fee (RMB2000 payable in cash, bank transfer or WeChat pay)

☐ Step 3: Admission

An email will be sent within 5 working days notifying whether the student has received an offer of placement* or has been denied.

☐ Step 4: Enrollment**

Before a student can start school the following must be completed.

- a. Complete and submit the Student Medical Report
- b. Payment of the enrollment deposit.

A non-refundable enrollment deposit is part of the total tuition and is required to reserve a space. The deposit is due according to the tuition invoice and it must be paid before the student is enrolled to start school. All other fees and tuition must be paid according to the payment schedule on your invoice.

Please note

*An offer of placement is not enrollment. To have your child enrolled in our school step 4 must be completed prior to their start date.

** Any missing documents or incomplete payments may result in a delayed start for your child. We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring all these matters are handled in their entirety and in a timely manner.

*A non-refundable **enrollment deposit** is part of the total tuition and is required to reserve a space for the 2026–27 school year. For returning students the deposit is due on or before June 12, 2026. For students admitted after this date, the deposit is due upon receipt of invoice. **Discount for returning students:** If the Enrollment Deposit is paid before May 15, 2026, there will be a 15,000 RMB discount (not applicable to JK half-days).

Payment methods

All fees can be paid via the following methods: Bank Remittance or RMB cash.

Important notes about bank remittance

1. Handling Fees
All transfer fees must be charged to your account, not taken out of school tuition.
2. The bank remittance description line must include one of the following (parents/companies bear full responsibility for any consequences arising from missing remarks):
 - The tuition invoice number (located in the top right-hand corner).
 - Student's full name (should match their passport) and grade level.

Financial policies

1. Parents are responsible to see that payment is properly made, and adhere to the requirements outlined in the student handbook.
2. Payment of the enrollment deposit is due within 5 days upon receipt of the school invoice and before the first day of attendance.
3. Enrollment is not considered complete, nor will a seat be reserved for a student, until the enrollment deposit has been received.
4. In case of an early withdrawal with unpaid tuition or fees still outstanding, no school records will be released or transferred, nor will academic credit be granted, until that account is paid in full.
5. All tuition and fees are based on the RMB amount. The RMB fees will not change. For USD payments, the school will issue a USD invoice using the Bank of China's RMB-to-USD exchange rate from the beginning of the month.
6. The enrollment deposit is payable annually upon enrollment and is non-refundable.
7. Any Academic Special Needs Services fees, if required, are payable annually upon enrollment and are non-refundable.
8. Any English Language Services fees, if required, are payable annually upon enrollment. Second semester fees are refundable at the end of the first semester should the student withdraw from school, change from Service B to A, or be determined to no longer require Services. Students who withdraw from school or whose level of service change during the second semester

are ineligible for refunds.

9. Tuition is charged and refunded according to full quarters, less the non-refundable enrollment deposit. Once a student has started a quarter, regardless of the number of days attended, full tuition for that quarter must be paid. Tuition is refunded only for full quarters not attended, and less the non-refundable enrollment deposit.
10. The bus fee, if required, is refunded according to full quarters. The bus fee should be paid in full according to the invoice, before a student may ride the bus.
11. No portion of tuition shall be refunded for a student dismissed by expulsion or for disciplinary reasons.
12. Tuition and fees are non-transferable to another student.
13. The school provides an iPad for all Grade 3 and new Grades 4–6 students. Grades 7–12 students must have their own MacBook. School-provided iPads are to be returned by students who withdraw during the first year-and-a-half of receiving an iPad, or they can be purchased at 75% cost when withdrawing after the first semester, 50% after the second semester, or 25% after the third semester. Students who do not pay the enrollment deposit by the May deadline in the first year of being given an iPad must turn in the iPad for the summer or purchase it according to the schedule above. Students must plan to use their iPads for at least three years.
14. Payments should be made on time or a late fee of 1,000 RMB will apply for accounts more than 5 business days overdue. Payments more than 10 business days past due will be subject to an additional 1,000 RMB late fee. Payments more than 20 business days past due may lead to students being excluded from class until payment is made.
15. For families with three or more children attending the school. A 20% discount on remaining tuition for the third and subsequent children in one family will

Parent FAQ

Here are answers to some of the most common questions

What time does school start and finish?

Our school day starts at 8:00 and finishes at 15:15.

Is there a dress code or school uniform?

We do not have a school uniform but there is a dress code students must to adhere to. The dress code can be found in the Student Handbook.

Is enrollment at the start of the school year only?

No, we have a rolling enrollment, so students can be enrolled during the school year.

What education system is used at the school?

We offer an American-based curriculum based on the AERO (American Education Reaches Out) framework. In our secondary school we offer a wide range of AP (Advanced Placement) courses.

Since you offer an American-based curriculum, can my child enter universities outside the US?

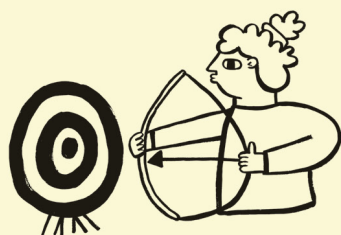
Yes, we have many students enter universities outside the US, such as Korea, the United Kingdom, Australia, Japan, Canada, to name a few.

To be eligible for enrollment, what documentation does my child need?

One of the following conditions needs to be met for a student to be eligible for enrollment:

- Where at least one parent holds a foreign passport and is legally working, visiting or studying in Tianjin. Tourist (L) visas are excluded.
- Where the parents and the child all hold foreign passports, and the child lives in Tianjin with a legal guardian.
- Where the parents have either a Hong Kong, Macau, or Taiwan residency permit and hold a Mainland Travel Permit (Hong Kong/Macau residents) or Return Permit (Taiwan residents). The parents should also have the required border control stamps as well as work and live in Tianjin.
- Where at least one parent has a residency permit and proof that they have lived in the country of permanent residency for at least two years. The child will also be living with at least one parent or a legal guardian in Tianjin.
- The child was born overseas, with a legal birth certificate and the passport of the country of birth.

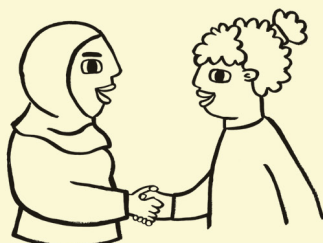
