




Going up in the world





Sustained language development

Daily 5 literacy program

By focusing on intentional instruction, along with extended periods of practice, students will see growth in their reading, writing, and listening proficiency. Students choose from five components each day: Read to Self, Work on Writing, Word Work, Read to Someone and Listening to Reading.

Furthermore, students interested in visual and performing arts can participate in our fine arts program




where they develop their skills and express their passion. Our high school facility is designed to give our high school students the right path to success for their future, and we've succeeded on getting many into top universities around the world.

English Language Support (ELS)


We are committed to excellence and believe all students can reach their highest potential through a quality education program.
