The faculty is predominantly from the United States, with others from China, France, Korea, Brazil, Panama, the Philippines, Nigeria, Azerbaijan, Ethiopia and New Zealand. Our teachers have at least two years of teaching experience.

Tianjin International School is accredited by Cognia, the largest education improvement organization in the world—demonstrating our commitment to learners, teachers, leaders and communities.




Graduation + credit requirements

Grading + GPA

Due to the transient nature of our student body and the diversity of educational backgrounds, we do not report class rank, nor do we use prior school records in calculating GPA. The cumulative GPA reported on the transcript is calculated from courses completed at Tianjin and from any Dual Enrollment courses taken through GCU. AP/Dual Enrollment courses are weighted with an extra 0.66 points.


